# Code of Ethics

### For Members of the PLCA Unit Owners' Sub-Committees

**ARTICLE 1:** Sub-Committee members should familiarize themselves with the Community By-laws, Covenants and Articles of Incorporation.

**ARTICLE 2:** Committee members should attend as many Unit Owners' Committee meetings and PLCA Board of Directors meetings and as often as possible.

**ARTICLE 3:** Committee members should keep themselves up to date on matters affecting the amenity that their committee represents so that they can inform the UOC.

**ARTICLE 4:** If a committee member perceives a potential conflict on an issue because of any other involvement, that member should recuse themselves from voting on that issue.

**ARTICLE 5:** Committee members should safeguard the interests of their constituents as a unit and the development as a whole by bringing to the attention of the UOC any circumstance which could be damaging or bring discredit to our community.

**ARTICLE 6:** Committee members should not seek any unfair advantage, privilege or concession because of their position in the community.

**ARTICLE 7:** Committee members should not accept any compensation (except as reimbursement) for duties performed in connection with UOC or PLCA activities.

**ARTICLE 8:** Nothing in this Code of Ethics should be construed to limit the ethical behavior expected of each committee member. Truth, honor, integrity and general rules of fair play should govern each representative's actions while in office.
